

Scientific Drawing Rubric

A The drawing captures **detailed** observations of the specimens or props studied. The drawing is labeled and has a complete heading. Relevant descriptions or answers to questions are attached and complete. Important structures or parts are labeled. Color is used if requested in class. A sense of scale is provided.





B The drawing captures **considerable** observations of the specimens or props studied. A few parts are absent that would increase the amount of information communicated through the drawing.



Student's drawing records **some** observations of the specimens or props as general impressions.

Neatness and lack of detail prevent the reader from interpreting all parts of the drawing. Labels, descriptions or other important features are absent.
